

## **Weekly Media Monitor**

October 2nd - 8th, 2023

This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy sector:

- Public Procurement Regulatory Authority has allowed Pakistan LNG Limited to procure 12 spot cargoes of LNG for six months, from January to June 2024.
- The caretaker government has decided to hand over power distribution companies to the private sector through 'long-term concessions'.
- Power sector circular debt is continuing to grow despite all the repeated tariff increases on a monthly, quarterly and annual basis.
- The caretaker government has notified the five-year National Electricity Plan 2023-27, under which the government will ensure 100% energy access to all by 2030, while the share of indigenous resources in the generation mix will increase to 60% and 75% by FY2025 and FY2030
