## December 11th - 17th, 2023

This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy sector:

- Speaking at COP-28 in Dubai, the United Nations secretary general, António Guterres, calls for urgent action to eliminate fossil fuel usage and emphasizes the need for global cooperation and swift transition towards renewable energy to achieve climate goals.
- ⇒ A 2-billion US dollar coal-fired power plant in Tharparkar achieves financial closure. The plant, run by Shanghai Electric Corporation, China, is already operational and is using coal mined from Thar Coalfield Block-I.
- The federal petroleum ministry warns that the gas sector's circular debt may surge by 275 billion rupees if gas prices are not increased further.
