

Weekly Media Monitor

March 4th - 10th, 2024

This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy sector:

- The Sui Southern Gas Company (SSGC) warns of a 50 percent decline in Pakistan's indigenous gas reserves by 2027 and encourages prudent practices for gas utilization.
- The Sui Northern Gas Pipeline (SNGPL) starts to supply a blended system of local and Regasified Liquefied Natural Gas (RLNG) to industries in the ratio of 25:27 amidst dwindling local supplies.
- ⇒ Hub Power Co Ltd (HUBCO) forecasts falling power demand for the current fiscal year owing to frequent tariff surges and industrial slump.
- ⇒ The National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (NEPRA) states in its annual report for 2023 that Pakistan's economic growth rate declined to 0.29 percent in the previous fiscal year owing to increased electricity tariffs.
