- ➡ Sindh Engro Coal Mining Company (SECMC) signs a loan agreement with Meezan Bank to finance the expansion of a coal mine in Thar Coalfield Block II.
- ➡ Rooftop solar installation surges in Pakistan, pushing up the share of solar in the power mix from 10 percent to over 25 percent by early 2025.
- ➡ Climate change will drive 41 million more people into extreme poverty by 2050.
