

Weekly Media Monitor

August 11th - August 17th, 2025

This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy and climate sectors:

- The federal government removes 207 megawatt Madyan and 88 megawatt Gabral hydropower projects from the national energy expansion plan amid warnings that their inclusion could raise electricity tariffs by 6 rupees per unit by 2034.
- Huaneng Shandong Ruyi Pakistan Energy, that owns Sahiwal coal power plant, files a suit against Central Power Purchasing Agency (CPPA) and National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (NEPRA) over coal procurement dispute.
- Pakistan ranks first on the Climate Risk Index 2025 despite contributing less than one percent to global greenhouse gas emissions.
