This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy and climate sectors:

- Sahiwal coal power plant warns that it might halt its operations due to rail wagon shortage for coal transport.
- Sindh Assembly unites against a National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (NEPRA) decision to allow K-Electric to recover 50 billion rupees in losses through consumer bills.
- Punjab grapples with intensifying climate events as early monsoon rains surge 30 to 36 percent above normal, triggering record floods.
- Pakistan launches a remote sensing satellite from China to enhance Earth observation for agriculture, infrastructure and disaster management.
