This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy and climate sectors:

- ➔ Balochistan launches a new climate change policy with a 500 million rupees fund with the plan modernizes 45 brick kilns, relocates 28 chromite mills, and installs 29 waste treatment plants and 18 industrial scrubbers. The federal cabinet directs all energy sector financial matters to be submitted to the cabinet committee on energy for strategic sector-wide decisions.
- ➔ A three-member federal panel begins review of Sindh Engro Coal Mining Company phase-three mine expansion after a year-long delay to boost coal output from 7.6 million tonnes per annum to 11.4 million tonnes per annum.
- ➔ World leaders gather in Belém for the 30th United Nations Climate Change Conference, COP30, amid geopolitical tensions, record global temperatures, and stalled climate commitments.
