This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy and climate sectors:

- ➔ Industrial associations reject the government's three-year concessional electrify package, citing tariff disparities that threaten competitiveness.
- ➔ A 660 megawatt mine-mouth coal power plant (owned by Hub Power Company Limited) at Thar Block II reaches completion on October 31, 2025.
- ➔ Pakistan cancels 21 LNG cargoes under its long-term deal with Eni, an Italian multinational specializing in oil, gas and energy, to reduce its surplus supplies.
