This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy and climate sectors:

- One of China's largest solar-panel producers, LONGi, says that domestic assembly of solar panels in Pakistan remains economically uncompetitive, with locally produced panels costing about 30 per cent more than the exported one and yet also failing to meet quality standards.
- The federal government claims that the diversion of 24 LNG cargoes to be imported from Qatar in 2026 will yield savings of over 1,000 billion rupees.
- Air pollution kills 256,000 people in Pakistan every year — a figure that outpaces deaths from terrorism.
