December 22th - December 28th, 2025

This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy and climate sectors:

- ➡ The federal cabinet's committee on energy approves pilot wheeling auction under the Competitive Trading Bilateral Contract Model (CTBCM), with 800 megawatts to be sold and purchased by private parties at an indicative wheeling charge set at 12.55 rupees per unit.
- ➡ The State Bank of Pakistan issues regulatory framework for effective management of climate-related financial risks, requiring all financial institutions to integrate climate risk into their governance, strategy and risk management.
- ➡ Pakistan and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) sign two loan agreements totaling 730 million US dollars to enable the evacuation of 2,300 megawatts of electricity from upcoming hydropower projects, reduce grid strains and improve the working of state-owned enterprises.
