This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy and climate sectors:

- ➡ Coal-fired power plants repatriated 135 million US dollars in profits in October even when power generation from imported-coal plants fell 54 per cent.
- ➡ Pakistan's rooftop solar generation will exceed daytime grid demand next year in certain industrial regions such as Lahore, Faisalabad and Sialkot.
- ➡ Sindh government earns 14.7 million US dollars through carbon-credit sales.
