

Weekly Media Monitor

December 29th, 2025 - January 4th, 2026

This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy and climate sectors:

- ➔ Lucky Electric Power Company Limited, a privately owned coal-based power producer, requests Power Minister Awaiz Leghari to expedite the completion of Thar coal rail link so that the company can avoid costs on coal imports.
- ➔ Pakistan and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) sign climate resilience projects worth over 300 million US dollars to strengthen coastal protection and promote climate smart farming.
- ➔ Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif directs new oil and gas exploration and the digitisation of the petroleum sector to curb smuggling and save foreign exchange.
- ➔ Pakistan will reportedly import 88 liquified natural gas (LNG) cargoes from Qatar in 2026, though 24 of these cargos will be diverted to other countries..
