December 15th - December 21th, 2025

This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy and climate sectors:

- National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (NEPRA) forms new net metering rules, bringing down the buyback rate from more than 25 rupees per unit to around 11 rupees per unit, banning sale of excess electricity to other consumers, limiting generation capacity and applying separate tariffs for buying and selling of electricity units.
- Pakistan requests a major Asian Development Bank (ADB) loan to retire 1.7 trillion rupees circular debt, refinance expensive power sector borrowing and support grid stability and smart metering expansion.
