






Weekly Media Monitor

June 1st, 2026 – June 7th, 2026

This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy and climate sectors:

- ➔ The Central Power Purchasing Agency (CPPA) seeks a 1.74 rupees per unit fuel cost adjustment for June electricity bills due to higher generation costs linked to LNG supply disruptions during the Iran-US conflict.
- ➔ The Pakistan China Joint Chamber of Commerce and Industry (PCJCCI) welcomes the 1.12 billion US dollar coal-based fertilizer plant under China Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC).
- ➔ Electric bike adoption grows in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa amid rising fuel prices, while battery-charging infrastructure gaps and frequent load shedding continue to hinder wider use.
- ➔ The federal government seeks to defer liquefied natural gas (LNG) terminal capacity charges after Qatar halted LNG supplies under force majeure, aiming to reduce electricity costs for consumers.
