



# Weekly Media Monitor

June 15th, 2026 – June 21th, 2026

This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy and climate sectors:

- ➔ The Power Division reports that Pakistan's power sector circular debt flow reached 1.857 trillion rupees by April FY2026, driven by unpaid dues from K-Electric and delays in government subsidy payments.
- ➔ Climate experts warn that the FY2027 federal budget reduces allocations for climate mitigation, adaptation and green subsidies despite Pakistan's growing climate vulnerabilities.
- ➔ Imported coal generation remains nearly 48 percent above reference levels in May 2026, despite improved hydropower generation and the partial return of RLNG-based power generation.
- ➔ The federal government allocates 2.478 billion rupees for climate-related projects in FY2027, with 2.335 billion rupees earmarked for the Green Pakistan Programme to support afforestation, biodiversity conservation and ecosystem restoration.
