






Weekly Media Monitor

June 8th, 2026 – June 14th, 2026

This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy and climate sectors:

- ➔ The FY27 budget extends incentives for electric vehicle Completely Knocked Down (CKD) kits until June 2027 but increases duties on imported EVs priced above 20 million rupees, while the Auto Policy 2026–31 awaits approval.
- ➔ The Economic Survey 2025-26 says Pakistan's installed power generation capacity reached 49,651 megawatt (MW) in FY2026, while coal consumption increased amid declining gas use.
- ➔ The UK-backed Climate Finance Accelerator selects 11 Pakistani businesses for investment support to scale climate solutions across clean energy, transport, waste management, and sustainable development sectors.
- ➔ A Policy Research and Advisory Council (PRAC) report warns that higher petroleum levies are fueling inflation by raising transport and energy costs despite efforts to curb price pressures through monetary policy.
