June 29th, 2026 – July 05th, 2026

This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy and climate sectors:

- ➔ The Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (OGRA) reduces liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) prices by 21.8 percent for July, lowering the price of an 11.8-kilogram domestic cylinder to 2,848.9 rupees.
- ➔ The Economic Coordination Committee (ECC) approves 52 billion rupees for the power sector and reallocates 97.649 billion rupees in electricity subsidies from K-Electric to other electricity distribution companies (DISCOs).
- ➔ Public sector labour unions call on the federal government to halt the proposed privatisation of electricity distribution companies (DISCOs), warning that it would increase electricity tariffs, threaten jobs and worsen Pakistan's power sector.
