

Weekly Media Monitor

July 06th, 2026 – July 12th, 2026

This week's major news updates in Pakistan's energy and climate sectors:

- ➔ The World Bank approves \$375.9 million in financing for the Grid Stability Enhancement Project to strengthen Pakistan's electricity transmission network and support renewable energy integration.
- ➔ The State Bank of Pakistan reports Pakistan will require an estimated \$331 billion in climate financing by 2030 to strengthen climate resilience and support climate-resilient development.
- ➔ NEPRA approves a fuel charges adjustment increase of 33.64 paise per unit for May 2026, applicable to consumers of DISCOs and K-Electric.
- ➔ Solar panel imports declined by 61% in the first five months of 2026 compared to the same period in 2025, while lithium-ion battery imports continue to increase.
- ➔ The federal government is considering a temporary exemption for state-owned energy companies from IFRS 9 and 14, a proposal opposed by the Central Monitoring Unit (CMU).
